I, (print name) \_\_\_\_\_, a member of University of Idaho Elmore County 4-H or FFA, fully understand the minimum weight limits of animals to be sold at the University of Idaho Elmore County 4-H Livestock sale at the Elmore County Fair in July.

1. I understand that on final weigh-in at the Elmore County Fair and I agree that if my animal does not meet the minimum weight at fair weigh-in I cannot sell but can show my animal in showmanship and feeder quality class.
  - Beef must weigh a minimum of 1150.
  - Swine must weigh a minimum of 220 pounds.
  - Sheep must weigh a minimum of 105 pounds; Barbados/Dorper must weigh a minimum of 70 pounds.
  - Goats must weigh a minimum of 65 pounds.
2. Market animals must be fed and pens cleaned the entire week of fair including Saturday and Sunday.
  - If pens are not cleaned every day to the satisfaction of the species chairman and the fair board, the member will be fined.
  - All non-sale animals must remain on the fairgrounds until Sunday. It is the member's responsibility to remove all non-sale animals from the fairgrounds from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
  - I will clean my animal's pen by Sunday, 2 p.m. If I fail to do so, I will be charged \$25 per animal cleaning fee for someone else to clean the stall.
3. I certify that all drugs and feed additives received by my animal have been used in conformity with the feed or drug manufacturer's directions and comply with withdrawal times as required by the Food and Drug Administration.
  - \*\*\*\*If I am in violation of this directive, my animal WILL NOT BE SOLD AT THE ELMORE COUNTY FAIR 4-H LIVESTOCK SALE.
4. IDAHO YOUTH LIVESTOCK PROGRAM COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE
  - I believe that participation in the Idaho Youth 4-H Livestock Program should demonstrate my own knowledge, ability, and skill as a feeder and exhibitor of livestock.
  - I will do my own work to the full extent of which I am capable and otherwise will only accept advice and support from others.
  - I will not use abusive, fraudulent, illegal, deceptive or questionable practices in the feeding, fitting, and showing of my animal(s), nor will I allow my parents, my supervisor, or any other individual to employ such practices with my animal(s).
  - I will read, understand, and follow the rules, without exception, of all livestock shows in which I am a participant and ask that my parents and the supervisor of my project do the same.
  - I wish for my livestock project to be an example of how to accept what life has to offer, both good and bad, and how to live with the outcome.
  - I consent to having my animal(s) subjected to drug testing.
  - I realize that I am responsible for: The proper care and safe humane treatment of my animals, the production of high quality, safe, and wholesome food, and demonstrating strong moral character as an example to others.
