Common Lilac | *Syringa vulgaris*
Cut flowers, hedge, fragrance

Red Osier Dogwood | *Cornus stolonifera*
Winter color, hedge

Oregon Grape | *Mahonia aquifolium*
Berries, fragrance

Viburnum | *Viburnum vibernum*
Wide variety of shapes, sizes, flowers

Serviceberry | *Amelanchier alnifolia*
Bird habitat, native, easy to grow

Spirea | *Spirea spirea*
Wide variety of shares, sizes, flowers

Forsythia | *Forsythia intermedia*
Spring flower, low maintenance

Cotoneaster | *Cotoneaster contoneaster*
Low growing, sprawling, berries

Vine Maple | *Acer circinatum*
Fall color, easy to grow, native

Euonymus | *Euonymus euonymus*
Interesting leaf color, spring through fall
