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There are only a small number of scholarships available. In the past years, six to eight scholarships have been awarded. The scholarships are as follows:

HORSE CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

The Horse Camp Committee sets aside \$1 out of each camper's registration fee to supply the scholarship fund. All 4-Hers attending camp are eligible to apply for this scholarship. The committee members will make decisions based on quality of application and evidence of need. (Approximately 6 scholarships available.)

INDIVIDUAL DONOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Various individuals, including Horse Camp Instructors donate scholarships to deserving young people. Those individuals will be consulted regarding the awarding of scholarships. (Approximately 3 scholarships available.)

KEELY LANCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Keely was loved by all at camp. She was an assistant bareback instructor, motivational speaker, and participant at camp. In 2012, Keely was taken from us in a car wreck. Her family has graciously sponsored one scholarship in remembrance of Keely for this year.

As the committee selects scholarship applicants, they base their decisions on the quality of application, including whether the member has actually done the work, as well as evidence of need.

Please note that applications filled out by the parents generally will not be considered.

Requirements for Application:

1. Must be currently (paid member) enrolled in the 4-H Horse program in District IV.
2. Must reside in the Idaho Eastern District.
