## 4-H Requirements to Exhibit at the Owyhee County Fair

General Requirements	Details
Enroll in 4-H and pay necessary dues.	Enroll on ZSuite and pay dues to your 4-H Leader by March 1. (Scholarships for dues are available, based on need, contact the Extension Office for details.)
Attend six or more club/project meetings.	Each member must attend six or more meetings to be eligible to participate in the Owyhee County Fair.
Complete a community service project.	The service project must be completed in Owyhee County.
Complete annual ethics training.	Each member must complete an ethics activity each year.
Give an oral presentation for <u>each</u> project.	Must be completed at a club or county level. (To qualify for the Outstanding Livestock Exhibitor award, this must be completed at the county level and the presentation must be on a livestock project-related topic.)
Complete an Involvement Report.	Complete on ZSuite, under the Record Books tab.
Complete a 4-H Project Record Book for <u>each</u> project.	Complete on ZSuite, under the Record Books tab.
Complete the checklist for your project(s) and submit to your leader before fair.	Must be signed by member, parent, and leader to be considered complete. Checklists can be found on the Owyhee County Extension website.
Market Animals Projects <u>only</u> : Provide copy of Bill of Sale.	A copy of the Bill of Sale must be included in the back of the member's record book.
Complete a record book interview.	Three interview dates are held before Fair. Youth must attend one of the three dates in order to qualify to participate at Fair.
Submit fair entries.	Entries are open June 15 - July 15. Entries are required to exhibit at fair. No late entries. Complete entries at <a href="http://owyhee.fairmanager.com">owyhee.fairmanager.com</a> . The link will expire at midnight on July 15th.

- Project-specific requirements can be found in the 4-H Project Requirement Handbook. It is the member and their family's responsibility to be familiar with project-specific requirements.
- It is the member and their family's responsibility to satisfactorily complete Owyhee County's 4-H requirements to exhibit at Fair. Members who do not complete all requirements will be ineligible to exhibit in 4-H at the Owyhee County Fair.
- Check with your 4-H Leader to see if your club has any additional requirements.
